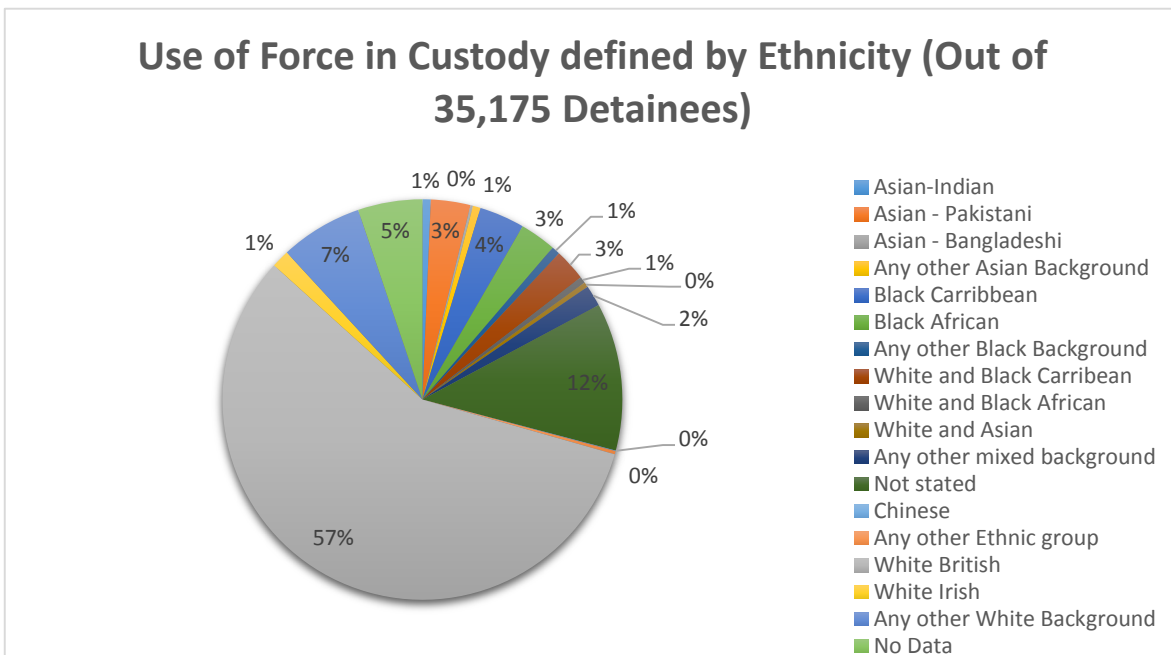
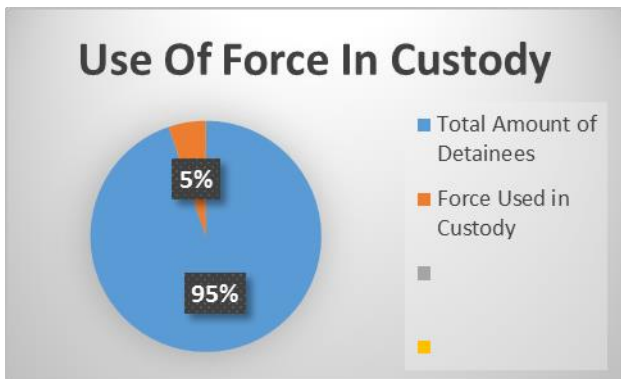
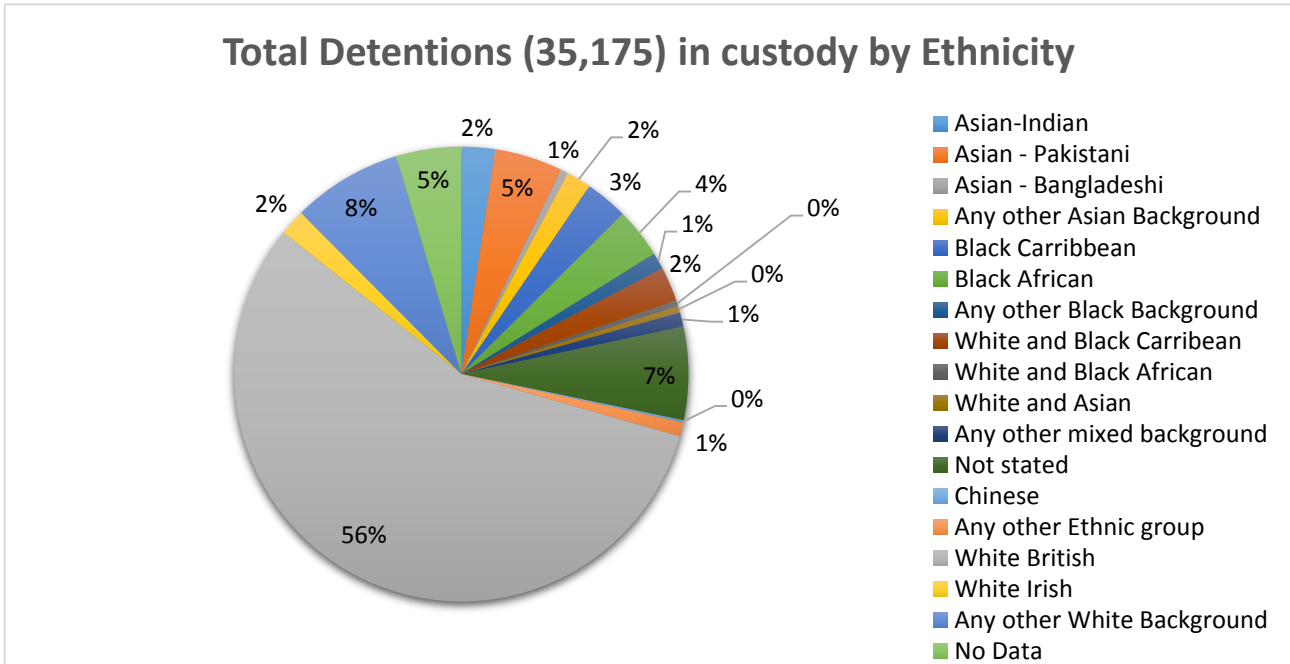


Thames Valley Police (TVP) have 8 Custody Suites and for the period 1st January 2016 to December 31st 2016 there were 35,175 people detained in TVP custody suites. Below you will find figures relating to use of force, amount of detainees and also detainees and use of force defined by ethnicity. You will see that use of force in custody is low compared to the amount of detainees just 5%.

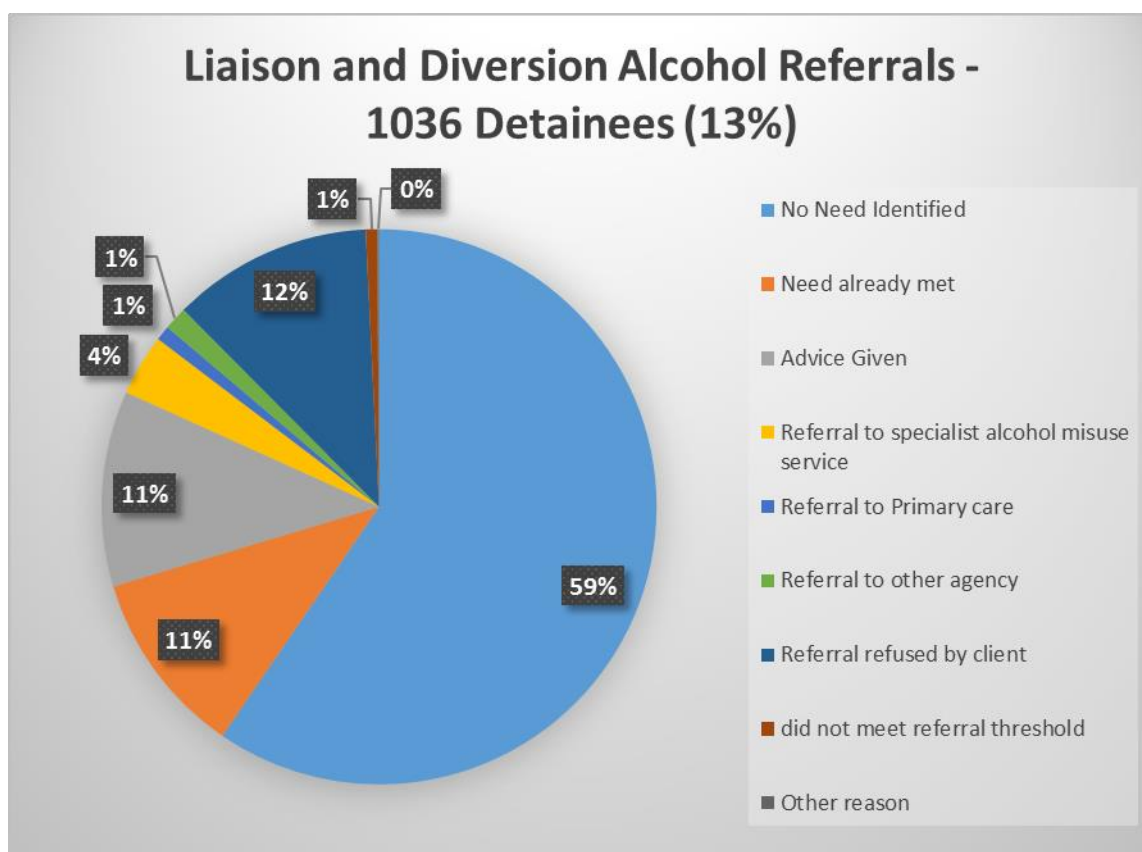


But Custody is much more than just detaining and either releasing, under investigation or charging and sending people to court. There are numerous diversions to support agencies and organisations that we complete for detainees. Also, use of force within custody on detainees is relatively low.

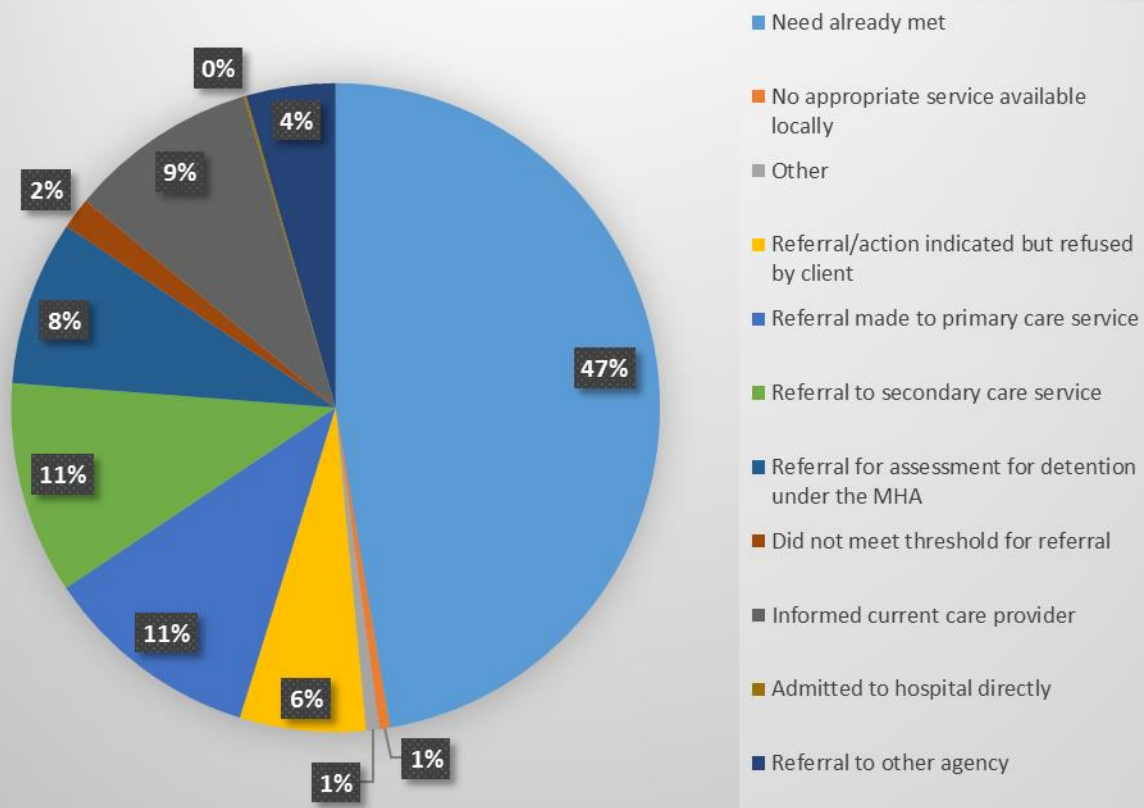
Our Custody Healthcare Care Professionals (HCP) are provided by Mountain Healthcare, 4 larger custody suites have a HCP 24 hours a day and 4 smaller suites utilise a mobile HCP who will travel between suites to provide cover.

As well as this we have Liaison and Diversion staff, employed by the NHS within several suites. These are Nurses with either Mental Health or Learning Difficulty specialisms. Although these are now in several suites, for the period 1st January 2016 to 31st December 2016 they were only in Oxfordshire suites so the figures provided below reflect this.

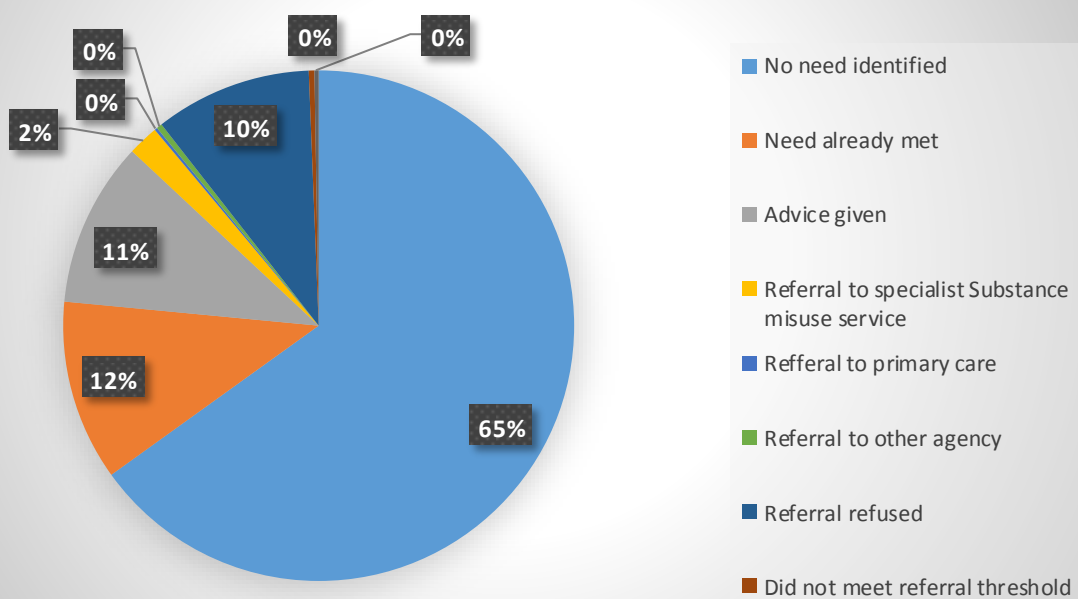

Liaison and Diversion referral for Mental Health - 765 detainees (9%)

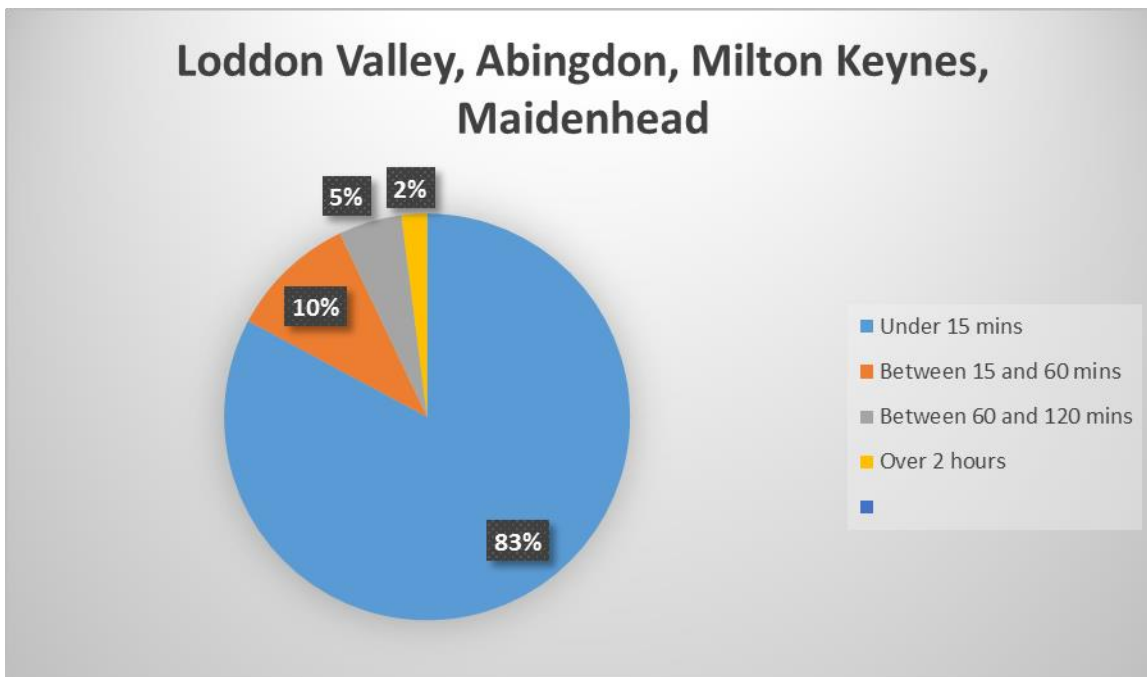


Liaison and Diversion Substance misuse referral



Custody Healthcare Professionals have seen 14,900 detainees between the period 1st January 2016 – 31st December 2016 for first time assessments. This equates to 42% of detainees. Of these 15 % (2,235) have been referred to other agencies including GP's. Timescales for assessing detainees following a request is as follows:
